HOME MINISTER INSPECTS NEIGRIHMS AND POLICE OUTPOST

Shillong, November 3, 2004: The Meghalaya Home Minister, Mr. H D R Lyngdoh today inspected the North East Indira Gandhi Regional Institute of Health and Medical Sciences (NEIGRIHMS) institution and the Police outpost at Mawdiangdiang in the outskirts of the city. Others who were present were the Director NEIGRIHMS, Dr. F U Ahmed, Additional Director General of Police, Mr. W R Marbaniang, Additional Director General of Police Mr. A Pradhan, Superintendent of Police, East Khasi Hills, Mr. A S Rynjah, Senior Government officials and officials of the Larson N Tubro Construction Company.

After the inspection of both the Police Outpost and the NEIGRIHMS complex, Mr. Lyngdoh informed that the State Government is very keen to see that the necessary needs of the institutions is fulfilled. He added that it is the duty of the State Government to see and to inspect such an institution. He also said that the new police outpost in the area would be inaugurated very soon which is adjacent to the institution which would help the institution.

The Director of NEIGRIHMS, Dr. F U Ahmed said that the total cost for the construction of the institution is Rs. 422 crores, adding that it will be commissioned by May, 2005 next year. Officials from the Larsan N Tubro informed that the total cost for the construction of the Police outpost is Rs. 1 crore for both the outpost and police quarter.

LITTERING AND PASSING URINE IN PUBLIC PLACES PROHIBITED

Shillong, November 3, 2004: With a view of keeping and maintaining a clean and healthy Shillong, the office of the Shillong Municipality Board has informed that a team of Municipality Inspectors would be moving around in public places and anyone found littering, passing urine will be subjected to a spot fine of Rs. 500/-.
